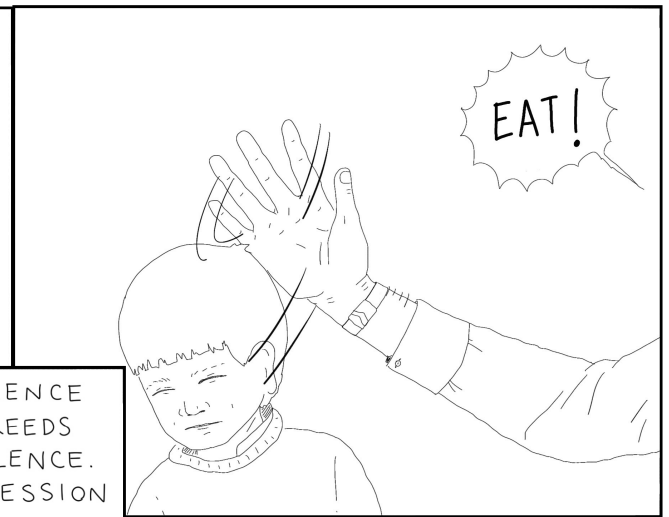
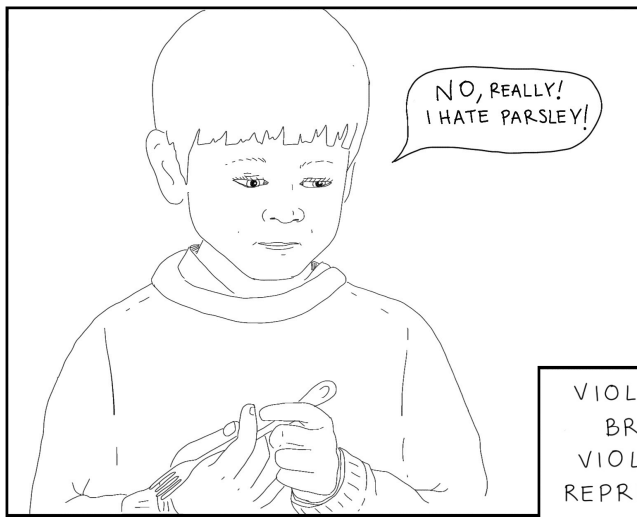

BEINGS.

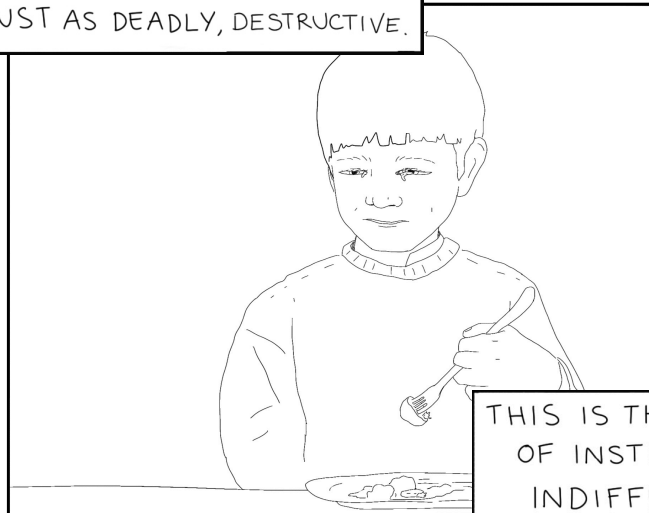

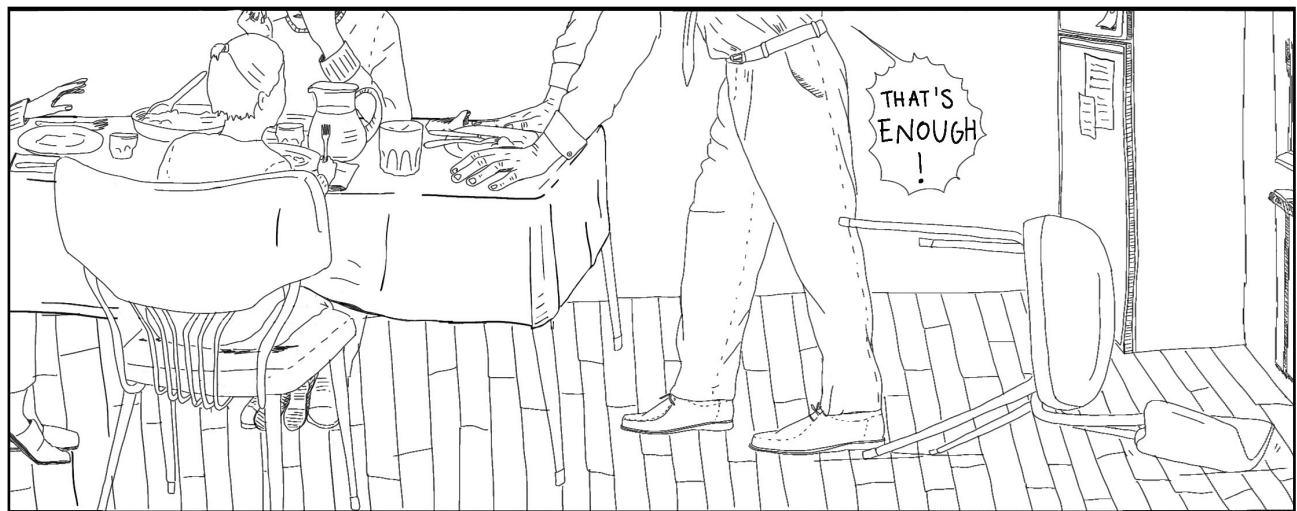

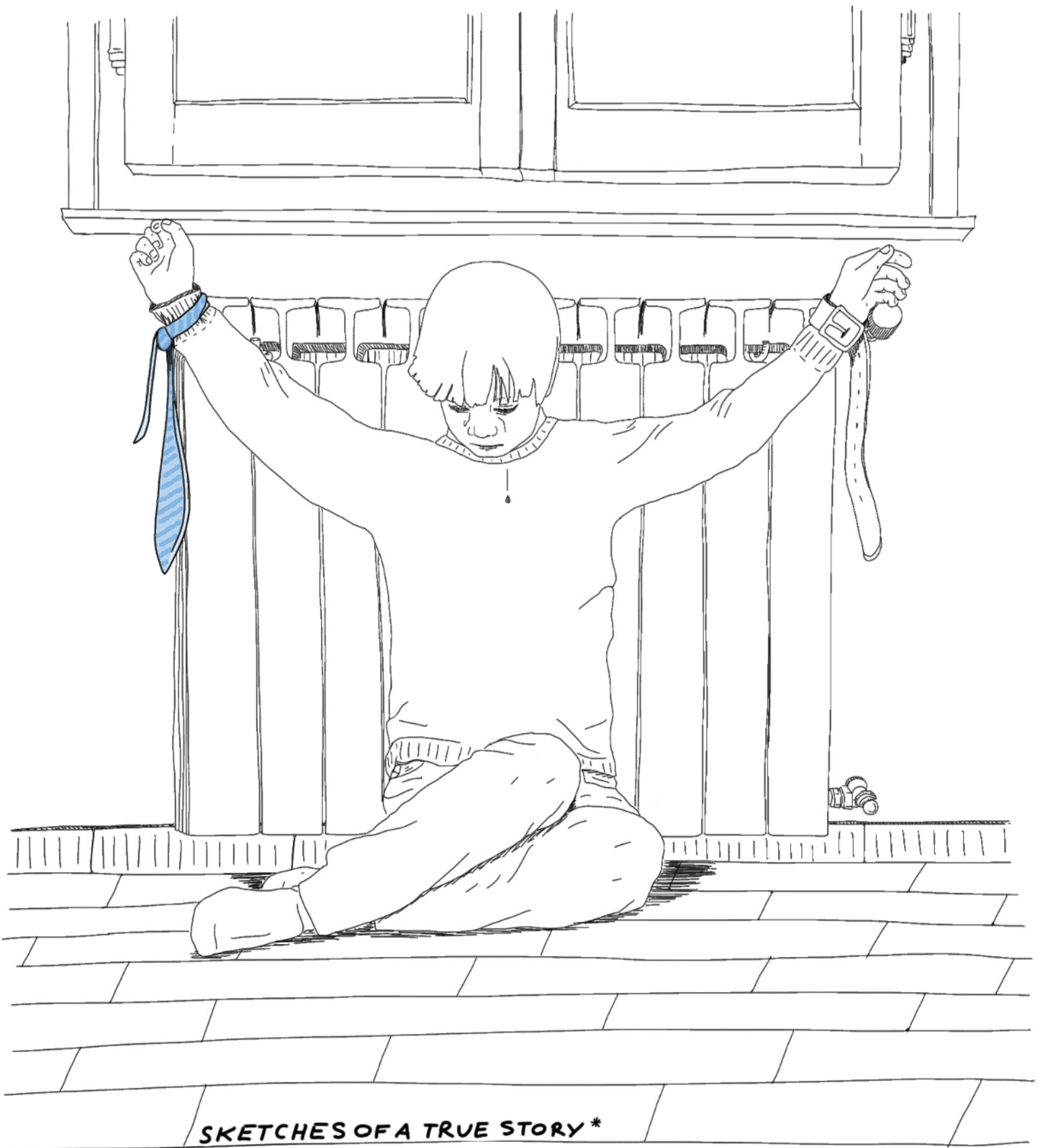
